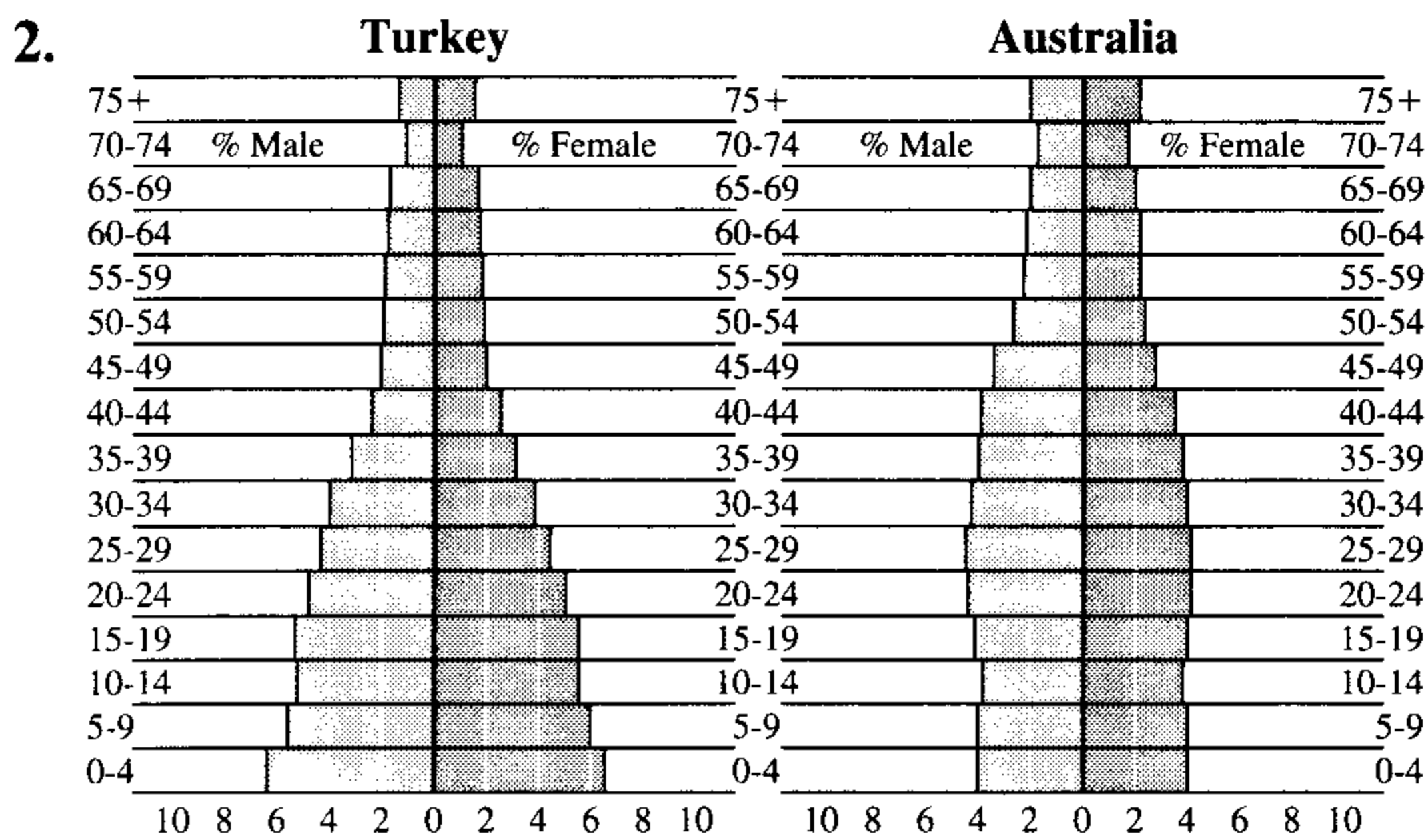
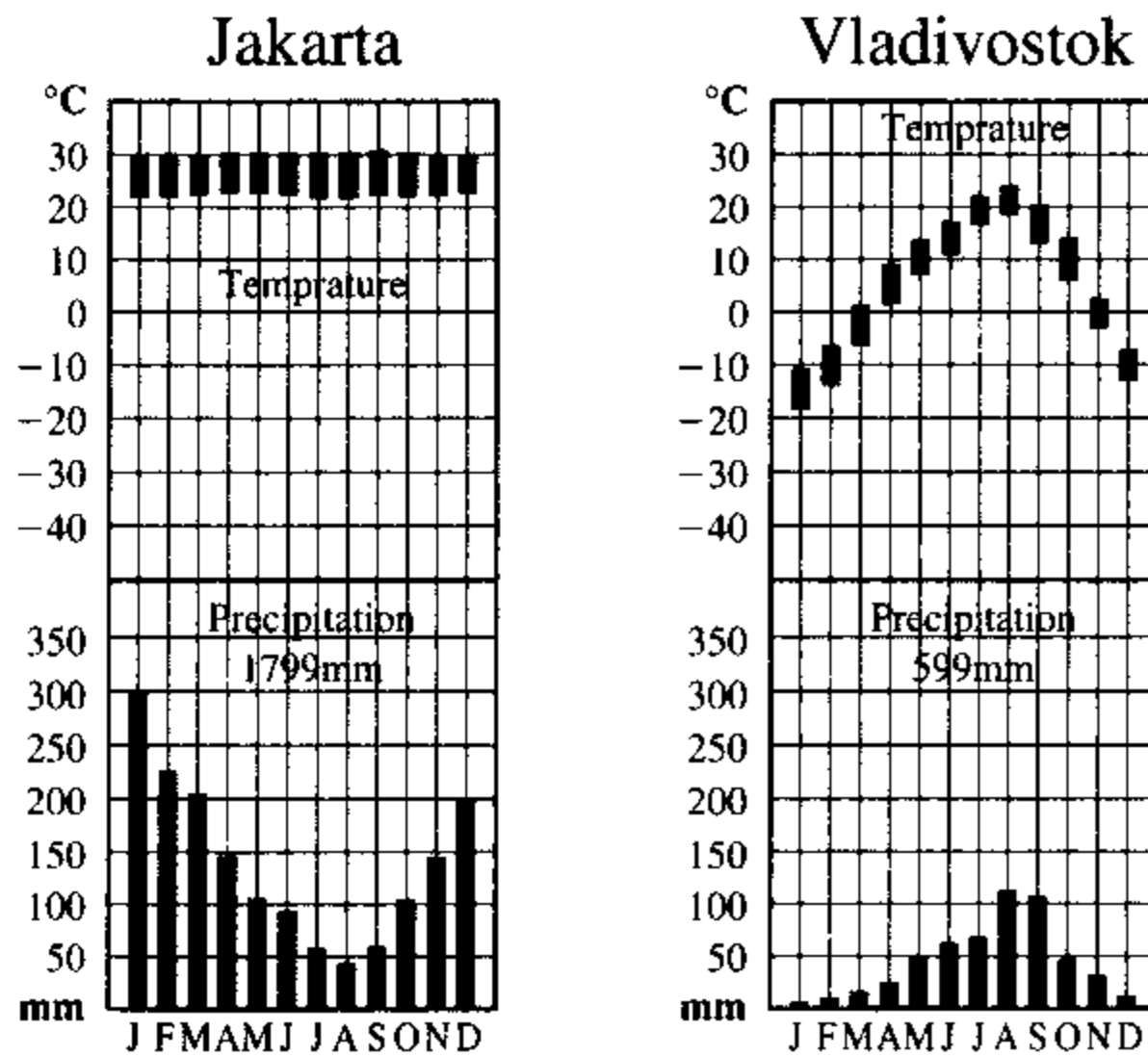


Exercise 2

Here are population pyramids for Turkey and Australia. The charts show, for example, that about 4% of the male population of Australia is aged 0-4.

- (b) Describe the main differences that the graph shows for Denmark and Niger. Why do you think these differences exist?
